A six-month internship in a studio, workshop, gallery, educational facility and research center dedicated to the safest and most sustainable printmaking practices available. A large portion of the internship included researching new techniques and products focused around non-toxic practices. We experimented with using printable PCB circuit board film to utilize as a way to easily get a photographic image with full tonal ranges on copper to be etched in ferric chloride.
